Secondary school

OLPS has a strong connection with secondary schools throughout the North Shore. We are so fortunate to have so many quality Catholic High Schools on our doorstep. The Diocesan High Schools have teamed up with our Primary Schools to offer a seamless K-12 transition. However, more importantly, OLPS recognises the importance of parent choice for their child's education and the rich and strong family connections with secondary schools. OLPS has reached out to High Schools to establish a strong connection to be able to offer an OLPS student a place for Year 7. All OLPS students have been successful to a secure a Year 7 place in their school of choice.

Within the Catholic School system, there are some secondary schools that offer a senior primary stream. However, OLPS has a relationship with these schools to assist with a Year 7 placement.



St Pius X Chatswood: With the first of its kind, OLPS is a feeder school to St Pius X Chatswood and guarantees a place for Year 7 pending criteria and application processes are followed.



Loreto Normanhurst: OLPS has a long history of students attending Loreto Normanhurst, and all our students have secured placement in Year 7. OLPS will partner with you during your application process and can provide excellent written recommendations for your Year 7 place.



St Ignatius Riverview: OLPS has a long history of students attending Riverview. CLPS will partner with you during your application process and can provide excellent written recommendations for your Year 7 place.
