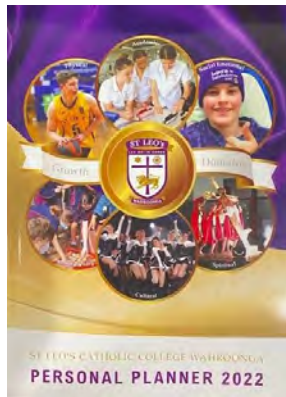
Key Differences Between 'Primary' & 'Secondary' Settings

- Normally a much larger school population (11-18 year olds)
 - Specialist Teachers (across all subjects)
 - Set number of hours in each 'KLA' (Key Learning Area) - Subject
 - Larger range of feeder schools
 - Co-curricular Activities
 - Independence
 - The influence of the peer group
 - The role of the parent/carer

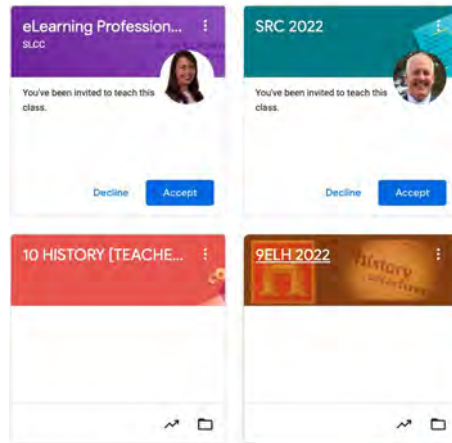

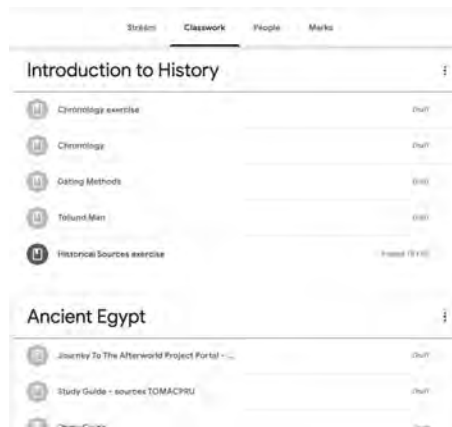

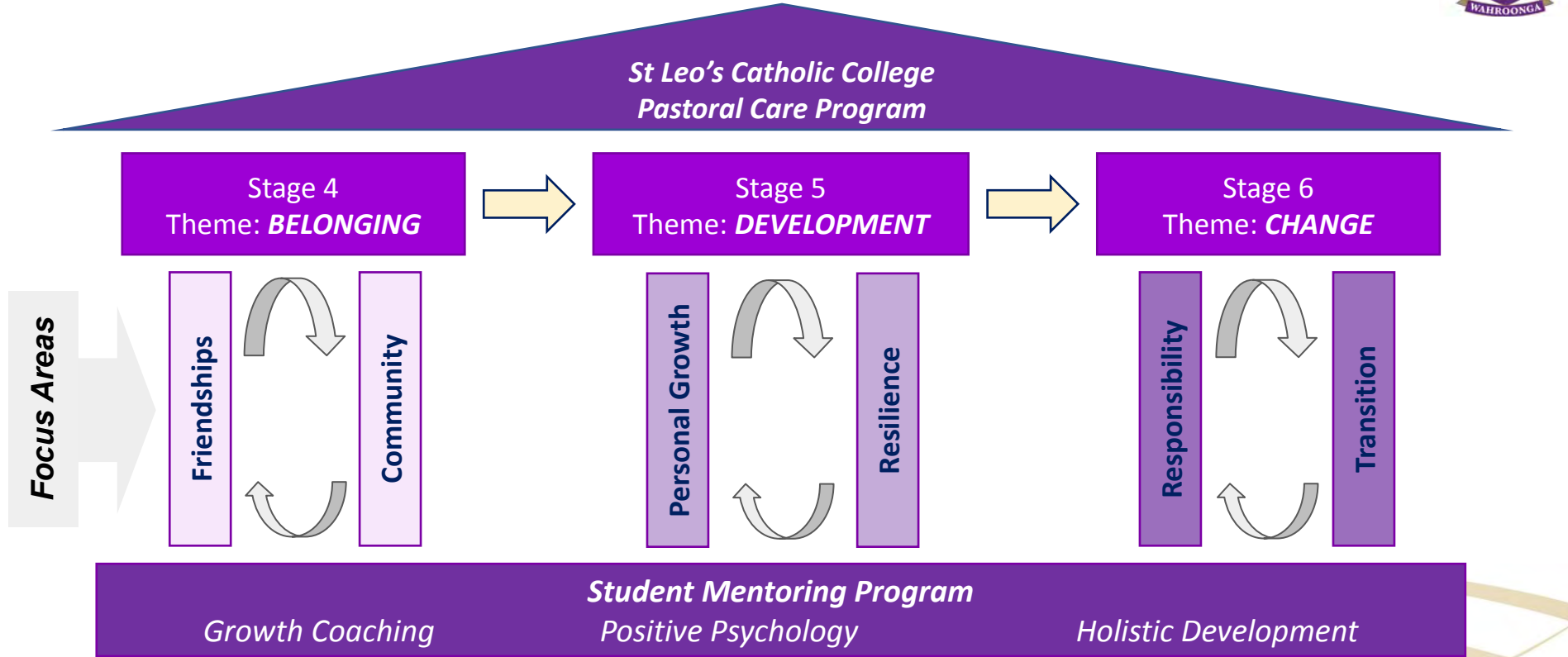
